Invoicing and Payment Details:

- All rates include 14% VAT
- After confirmation of the sponsorship and/or exhibition booking, an invoice for a 50% deposit of the agreed amount will be sent for immediate payment on receipt of invoice.
- Payment of the remaining 50% will be payable by 14 June 2017.
- Any new bookings received after 14 June 2017 will be liable for 100% of the invoice cost – immediately payable on receipt of invoice.
- Payments can be done via EFT.
